

Richmond Park win the Association Cup.

The Association Cup is a competition between the men's member clubs of the Richmond Park Association Golf Club (RPAGC). Each of the participating clubs enters four players in teams of two. The format is a four-ball better-ball Stableford and the handicap allowance is $\frac{3}{4}$ of the playing handicap of each player.

The Association Cup is awarded to the club with the best aggregate score (of the two pairs) and the top two individual teams qualify their clubs as the RPAGC's entries to the SCGU Kelso Hamilton Shield event for the following year.

This year's competition had entries from four of the RPAGC's member clubs and was very professionally arranged by Nigel Westwood, the RPAGC Secretary. It was a closely fought competition in which Richmond Park narrowly beat White Lodge men into 2nd place, with Putney Park only one point further back. The full result is given below.
