Prizes for:-
Nearest the Pin (men) $3^{\text {rd }}, 99^{\text {th }}, 14^{\text {th }}$ and $18^{\text {th }}$
Nearest the Pin (ladies) $3^{\text {rd }}, 9^{\text {th }}, 14^{\text {th }}$ and $16^{\text {th }}$
Longest Drive $8^{\text {th }}$ hole
Also, Team Competition (separate scorecard)
Each Fourball competes as a Team, with prizes for the best scores for the $1^{\text {st }}$ and $2^{\text {nd }}$ half of the games, and for $3^{\text {rd }}$ best score. Team scoring is by stableford points, with men off full handicap and ladies off 2 strokes less than their actual handicap (i.e. lady with handicap of 20 , scores in the team event off a handicap of 18).
