

# Dress Code

## For the Course and Club House

The management and members of Merrist Wood Golf Club expect all guests and visitors to maintain a reasonable standard of dress at all times whilst on the course and in the clubhouse.

We are not an old-school golf club with lots of draconian rules, but we do like to maintain certain standards. Please do not be offended if you are asked to leave the clubhouse or the course if you come up short.

### On the course

- Golf shoes **ONLY** are allowed on the course with soft or hard spikes.
- **NO** football or t-shirts.
- **NO** track suits, beach or athletic style shorts.
- **NO** blue denim jeans.
- **NO** cargo or fatigue style trousers or shorts allowed.
- Full length trousers or tailored shorts to the knee, not below: 3/4 length trousers are not permitted (excluding plus 2s or 4s).
- Tailored shorts may be worn with either knee length or sports socks.
- **NO** collarless shirts except modern turtle neck golf shirts.
- Shirts must be kept tucked in at **ALL TIMES**.
- **NO** sleeveless shirts
- Mobile phones must be kept in **SILENT MODE** and used **ONLY** in an emergency on the course.

### In the clubhouse

- You may wear soft spiked shoes throughout, as long as they are dry and clean.
- The use of mobile phones is permitted, but please be discreet.
- No baseball caps or hats to be worn.
- Please do not wear wet or muddy clothing.
- Our dress code is smart and casual. Jeans and collarless shirts, for instance, are acceptable, as long as they are smart. Please note, just because you paid a fortune for your designer ripped jeans, it does not automatically make them smart.
